

Donation Allocation Policy

Policy Purpose: To explain how restricted, general, and redirected donations are handled with transparency and care.

Restricted Donations

Donations designated for a specific purpose, such as Zakat, Sadaqah, Fidya, Kaffarah, Qurbani, Orphan Support, Educational Assistance, or Emergency Relief, will be used exclusively for those purposes.

General Donations

Undesignated donations will be directed to areas of greatest need, allowing Darul Infaq to respond promptly to urgent humanitarian situations and ongoing programs.

Program Flexibility

In the event that a designated project becomes fully funded, impractical, or no longer needed, Darul Infaq reserves the right to redirect funds to a similar charitable purpose that aligns with the donor's original intent and the organization's mission.

Administrative Expenses

Darul Infaq strives to keep administrative and operational expenses as low as possible. The vast majority of donations are utilized for charitable programs and direct beneficiary assistance.

Financial Accountability

Darul Infaq maintains detailed records of donations and expenditures. Financial reports, annual filings, and organizational updates are made available to donors to promote transparency and accountability.

Stewardship Commitment

We consider every donation an Amanah (trust) and are committed to utilizing entrusted funds responsibly, efficiently, and in accordance with Islamic principles and applicable laws.

Commitment: Donor trust, Islamic principles, and responsible stewardship guide how funds are received, recorded, allocated, and reported.
